A Message from Pastor Arlene: An excerpt from Pastor Arlene's University of the Holy Spirit daily devotion, Monday, March 17, 2014:

<u>Scripture</u>: 1 Corinthians 2:15—The person with the Spirit makes judgments about all things, but such a person is not subject to merely human judgments, for, who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

<u>Observation</u>: The Apostle Paul is speaking words to the people of Corinth, but he wants them to know that the words are not just his own, they are from God. This is a big leap, to



say you speak for God, but Paul says that when we have the Holy Spirit of God in us, we have the mind of Christ and so we can do this.

<u>Application</u>: What a frightening and awe-inspiring thing it is to know that I, and every person who says yes to Jesus and follows Jesus has been given the Holy Spirit who will give us Jesus' accurate interpretation of everything that happens in life inside of us and around us. It is easy to want to discard this responsibility of knowing the mind of Christ (and acting upon what we know) as too difficult or just for hyper-spiritual prophetic types of people. But no, it's for me, too. I have the mind of Christ because the Holy Spirit lives in me.

Prayer: Lord, keep me abiding in your Son Jesus Christ. Keep me trusting him, resting in my identity as his child, and relinquishing control of my life to him. This will allow me to hear the Holy Spirit, and know that what I hear comes from the mind of your Son, Jesus Christ, and not just from me. I love you, Lord. Amen.
