Holy Spirit Bible reading, Tuesday, April 1, 2014. (Get a UHS bookmark reading guide in the hallway and grow closer to Jesus through daily Bible devotions!)

<u>Scripture</u>: 2 Corinthians 1:3-10 All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is our merciful Father and the source of all comfort. He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. <u>When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the</u> <u>same comfort God has given us</u>. For the more we suffer for Christ, the more God will shower us with his comfort through Christ. Even



when we are weighed down with troubles, it is for your comfort and salvation! For when we ourselves are comforted, we will certainly comfort you. Then you can patiently endure the same things we suffer. We are confident that as you share in our sufferings, you will also share in the comfort God gives us. We think you ought to know, dear brothers and sisters, about the trouble we went through in the province of Asia. We were crushed and overwhelmed, beyond our ability to endure. In fact, we expected to die. <u>But as a result,</u> we stopped relying on ourselves and learned to rely only on God who raises the dead. And he did rescue us from mortal danger, and he will rescue us again. We have placed our confidence in him, and he will continue to rescue us.

Observation: The apostle Paul reminds the Corinthian believers that we are all connected with one another, that our pain helps one another, and we can all rely on God. **Application**: Lots of scripture spoke to me today. Paul reminds me that it is not all about me. It's all about trusting in God, and helping each other to remember it is all about God. **Prayer**: Lord, living is all about you, not me. And living is all about loving the people you love, not my own agendas. Help me to think with your mind, and love with your heart. I am with you in the journey!
