### A Message from Pastor Arlene:

Prayer is a good thing. Staying in constant contact with your creator, your sustainer, your savior, is a good thing. Communicating with God through prayer will keep you centered and content. Today in my University of the Holy Spirit reading, I enjoyed once again reading Psalm 139. I sincerely wish you would read and reflect on this Psalm some time soon.



It is a beautiful expression of King David, whom God called "a man after God's own heart", appreciating and acknowledging how completely God knew him. The prayer ends with this request that David makes of God: "Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life."

When I read this sincere cry of David's heart, the prayer resonates within my own. God knows everything about me, and I want to be all about loving God, doing God's will, serving him, and worshiping him. It is well for me to have such a close and trusting relationship with God that I can ask him to be completely honest with me, to show me any way that I am fooling myself, to examine my motives and my reactions, to correct me and guide me rightly. I resonate with needing my good, good, God to watch over me in this way.

This week, will you read Psalm 139 and pray this prayer as David did? Allow God to lead you in the way that is best for you. He loves you and wants you to know him and be connected with him!

Principle: When we are upset we usually focus on what we don't want.

Application: Instead of saying "Why isn't this homework done? Do you want to fail? How many times do we have to go over this?!" You could say "You can start with your math homework or reading. Which is best for you?" You have given them a direction and a choice - learning to make choices, especially good ones is a lifelong habit we all need! Focusing on what needs to be done eliminates negativity and helps the child know what is expected.
