A Message from Pastor Arlene:

For those of you who follow this "blog", you know I have been studying the words, actions, and life of Jesus as we travel through our Sunday series called "Jesus Revealed." As a follower of Jesus, I want to make sure I know him and that I do not disservice him by misunderstanding him or misrepresenting him to others. I want my actions and motivations to be purely out of love for the "real" Jesus: the way, the truth and



the life! So today, I read in the University of the Holy Spirit readings (get your bookmark of readings on the "Form" wall now!) more teachings of Jesus from the Gospel of Matthew. In chapter 23, Jesus was addressing the Pharisees, who were the religious elite who followed every religious rule and law down to the very last letter, but did not truly know God or love God. He was very tough with them because of their hypocrisy. He said, "Outwardly you look like righteous people, but inwardly your hearts are filled with hypocrisy and lawlessness."

Have you ever been more concerned with what people thought of you than what God thought of you? I mean even within the church—have you ever pretended to be more spiritual than you are, or have you ever thought that if you just looked good, and did the right things, maybe God would overlook your sins and like you better? If so, you are not alone, but let me tell you plainly that Jesus is more concerned with the inside of you than the outside of you. He wants a relationship, not just a rule follower. There are many things you can do to grow closer to Jesus in relationship. Worship, pray, read his Word, to name just three. I am with you in the journey!

There is a better way. Instead of asking yourself, "how am I going to get (make) my child stay in her bed," ask yourself, "How am I going to HELP my child more likely choose to stay in her bed?" The first question will give you manipulative coercive answers. The second question will give you creative, cooperative solutions.
