A Message from Pastor Arlene:

Today I read in my morning devotion, the words that Paul wrote to another Christ follower and leader named Titus (Titus Chapter 2, verse 1): "You, however, must teach what is appropriate to sound doctrine." These were wise words from a man who had spent his life teaching the truth of Jesus Christ's death on the cross



and resurrection for us. The verse struck me because the reason I am at Duke Divinity School this month is to be accountable to knowing sound doctrine so that I can teach it to you. The definition of doctrine is "a set of ideas or beliefs that are taught or believed to be true." This makes me take pause as I ponder how important "what you believe" really is.

Some people never really stop to think about what they believe, but everyone has a belief system. What they put the most of their time, money, thought, and emotional investment into, is their "doctrine of life." Since everyone has a doctrine, it is good to think about what yours is. We get to choose which is the most trustworthy and true doctrine to hang our lives on. Like the Apostle Paul, I believe in the ultimate truth that Jesus came to earth as God in the flesh, and took our punishment on the cross, and sent his Holy Spirit to lead us and help us in all circumstances. This is my highest doctrine, and I am glad to be at Duke reinforcing this glorious truth. I pray this is your doctrine, too. I am with you in the journey!
