A Message from Pastor Arlene:

This week I received a Facebook message from a young person who took up the challenge I placed in this Newsletter last Sunday to find where in the Bible did Moses have the encounter with the burning bush. He was guite pleased with himself to find the story! I also got another email from a woman who had a guestion about where Jesus' father Joseph was while Jesus was getting crucified, so I challenged her to research the answer and get back with me. She did, and came to some good conclusions that I learned from.



There are several places in the Bible where the analogy of 'milk' or 'meat' is applied to learning and digesting the Word of God. (Bible challenge this week: find out where, read what it says, and email me your thoughts!) 'Milk' would probably apply to more fundamental truths of the Word taught to us, while 'meat' would probably be more complex teachings or of some deeper order that we learn ourselves.

When we are children, we drink milk, and usually someone else is feeding it to us. (These would be the simpler truths that someone else tells us about Jesus.) But when we get older, we eat meat, and we have to cut it up ourselves, and hopefully each of us get to the point where we even buy it and cook it for ourselves, too! This means that eventually, each of us must not only consume what others feed us, but we ought also to form a close and intimate relationship with Jesus ourselves, with truths that he teaches each of us individually through prayer and his daily Word.

My prayer is that today is the day each of us begins to grow up in our personal relationship with God, spending time with him in his Word and hearing from him in prayer! No more milk, solid food! Bon Apetit! And I am with you in the journey!
