A Message from Pastor Arlene:

This week I read in my daily devotional readings (University of the Holy Spirit—get a bookmark of readings from the "Form" wall in the hallway), the words of Peter recorded in the book of John 6:68-69: Simon Peter replied, "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life. We believe, and we know you are the Holy One of God!"



Your challenge this week is to go into the gospel of John and take a look at what was happening when Simon Peter said these words to Jesus. The only hint I will give, is that after a series of events (what events?), Jesus turned to his disciples and asked them, "are you going to leave me, too?" I love Peter's response. Peter doesn't say, "Of course not, we are loyal to you!" or even, "We wouldn't even think of it!" Instead, Peter says, "where else would we go?" It sounds like Peter might have thought this through a little, and upon looking at all the angles, he realizes that there is no other option for the disciples except to follow Jesus. If there were any other option, Peter might have taken it!

I am very much like Peter, and perhaps you are, too! Sometimes my first response to Jesus' request that I follow him isn't a burning desire to do so. Sometimes it is only a last resort! Only after I have tried living life by my own terms, do I finally turn to Jesus, who is the only one who has the Key to Life, because he is the Holy One of God. And Jesus is always there waiting for me.

My prayer for you and for myself today, is that Jesus not be the last resort in our lives, but that following him be a joy that we rush into, just because we love him and because of all he has blessed us with. I am with you in the journey!
