## A Message from Pastor Arlene:

Earlier this week in my University of the Holy Spirit daily devotional readings (get a bookmark from the "Form" wall in the hallway if you want to join me in daily devotions), I read chapter 33 of the Old Testament book of Jeremiah. Jeremiah was a prophet through whom God chose to speak a word to the people of Judah about their idolatry and impending consequences of their sin. They would be taken captive by and be exiled to Babylon. As you can imagine, this was not a popular message. People didn't want to hear that. And frankly, Jeremiah didn't want to speak it. He argued with God that he was too young, too introverted, too unsettled, but to no avail. God had a message, and Jeremiah had to tell it, because God said he had to. If you read Chapter 33, count how many times it says "the Lord said" or "the Lord told me." You will find that before Jeremiah said anything, he prefaced it by saying that the Lord was giving him the message (probably hoping that they didn't "shoot the messenger.")

Have you ever had to have a difficult conversation with someone? One of the things we learned at the Willow Creek Leadership Summit was the importance of having crucial conversations, those that can change the trajectory of our life or another person's. Loving honesty is important, but it is also not a free pass to let our tongues run free. Like Jeremiah, we need to be sure we are actually hearing a word from God before we pass it on. Is this what Jesus would have us say? And also like Jeremiah, we must know that it is God and not ourselves that is compelling us forward to have the conversation. Do you have any conversations God is telling you to have today? I do, Seek ye first the Kingdom of God! I am with you in the journey.
