A NOTE FROM PASTOR SHARI:

Friends,

When I was young, in the weeks before Christmas, right in the center of our kitchen table was an advent wreath. Each week my parents would take us through a long (or what seemed to be long) liturgy of the meaning of the candle that we were lighting that night, as well as a refresher of the candles we'd lit in previous weeks. The wreath was always live, always beautiful, and always a welcome sight because it meant Christmas was coming! It was special for us to be able to actually light a candle and to hear Dad read about Jesus.

Why do I mention this? I have come to discover that, in many of our homes, we no longer carry on some of the traditions that we used to. One possible (unintended) result of this is that the only time our children hear about advent is at church. I want to suggest that it is not too late to start a tradition in your home where, at dinner or right before bedtime, you share the candle lighting and readings with your children. Scripture tells us to train our children in the ways of the Lord and this is a great way to share the nature of our Savior (Peace, Hope, Joy, Love). Here's to making your own family traditions.
