1. Live _____ in God.

As he considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. "Joseph, son of David," the angel said, "do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife. For the child within her was conceived by the Holy Spirit. And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." All of this occurred to fulfill the Lord's message through his prophet: "Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel, which means 'God is with us.'"

2. Live _____ to God.

When Joseph woke up, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded and took Mary as his wife. But he did not have sexual relations with her until her son was born. And Joseph named him Jesus.

Confession and Pardon

All Together: We confess, O God, that we have been less than child-like in our minds and hearts. Our hearts are filled with anxiety for our own personal welfare instead of with compassion for the least, the last, and the lost. We have forgotten to relax in Your presence, and we have been too busy to discover the deep joys of the Holy Spirit. We are not worthy to be called Your sons and daughters. Our thoughts are not Your thoughts, and our ways are not Your ways. Forgive us, we pray, and redeem us from all of our sin. In the name of the everlasting Savior, Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Leader: Hear the good news! Christ died for us while we were yet sinners; that proves God's love toward us! In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven!

All Together: In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven! Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again!
